How can I go abroad?

Mobility program of the International Office

- **Limited selection** (International agreements)
- + **Simplified application**
- + **Exemption** from **tuition fees**
- + **Scholarship** (if applicable)
- + **Support** with the organization

Self-organized stay

- + **Freedom in the choice of host institution**
- **Standard application procedure**
- Very high **high tuition fees** in some cases
- **No scholarship** from the University of Vienna
- No support with the organization

Mobility Programs

Student Exchange for Studies at Universities outside of Europe

250 – 500 €/per month,
Travel expense allowance

Research Projects for Diploma-/MA- Theses und Dissertations worldwide

650 – 1.050 €/, per month
Travel expense allowance

Student Exchange for Studies at Universities in Europe

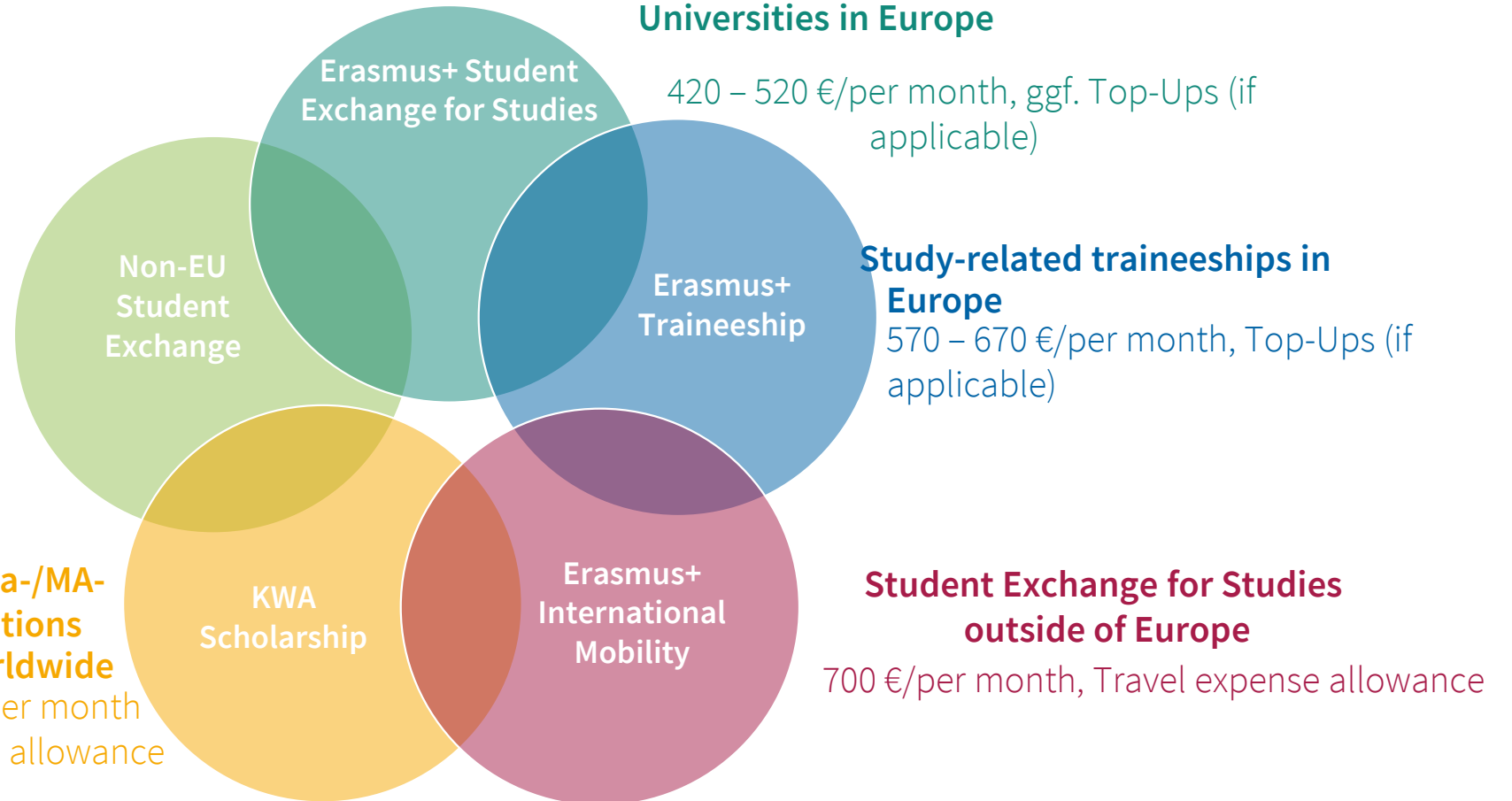
420 – 520 €/per month, ggf. Top-Ups (if applicable)

Study-related traineeships in Europe

570 – 670 €/per month, Top-Ups (if applicable)

Student Exchange for Studies outside of Europe

700 €/per month, Travel expense allowance

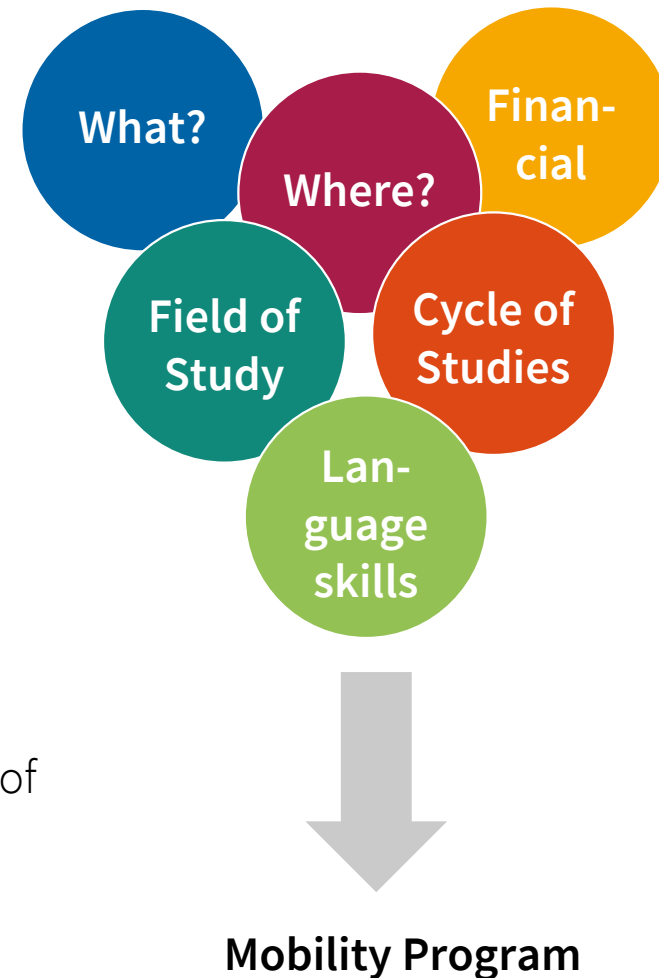

Which Exchange Program?

Important Factors:

- **What** would I like to do abroad?
- Which **country** would I like to go to?
- Is the exchange program open to my **field of study**?
- Do I have the right **level of study**?
- Do I have the necessary **language skills**?
- **When** would I like to go abroad? What are the semester dates of the host university?
- Can I **finance** my stay abroad?
- Can I have my **academic credits recognized**?



What would I like to do abroad?

- **Complete Courses**
 - Erasmus+ Student Exchange Program
 - Non-EU Student Exchange Program
 - Erasmus+ International Mobility
- **Writing a Thesis / Dissertation**
 - Erasmus+ Traineeship
 - Erasmus+ International Mobility
- **Research Project for the Thesis / Dissertation**
 - Short-term grants abroad (KWA)
 - Erasmus+ Traineeship
- **Gaining experience in the working life**
 - Erasmus+ Traineeship





Language Skills

- Language skills according to the **the requirements of the UW** and **host institution**
- Proof of language skills already **for the application (lead time!)**
- Type of language certificate **depends on the mobility program!**
- **Exceptions** for students of philology and translation studies:
 - **Erasmus+ Student Exchange:** no language certificate required for philology and translation study places
 - **Erasmus+ Traineeship:** no language certificate if you study the working language
 - **Non-EU Student Exchange Program:** Transcript of Records, if you are studying the language of instruction (except English-speaking countries)
- The **partner university** may still require a language certificate!

Financial matters: What do I need to consider?

- **Further costs at partner universities** (e.g. student union fee, campus fee, health insurance, visa costs, transcript fee etc)
- **Scholarships/Allowances**
 - Is it possible to obtain it during the stay abroad?
 - Is it possible to receive several scholarships/allowances at the same time?
 - If you receive a study allowance/Selbsterhalter*innenstipendium you can apply for a study allowance abroad
- **Salary / other income necessary?**
 - Part-time job allowed?
- **Cost of living** depending on host country and city
 - Rent

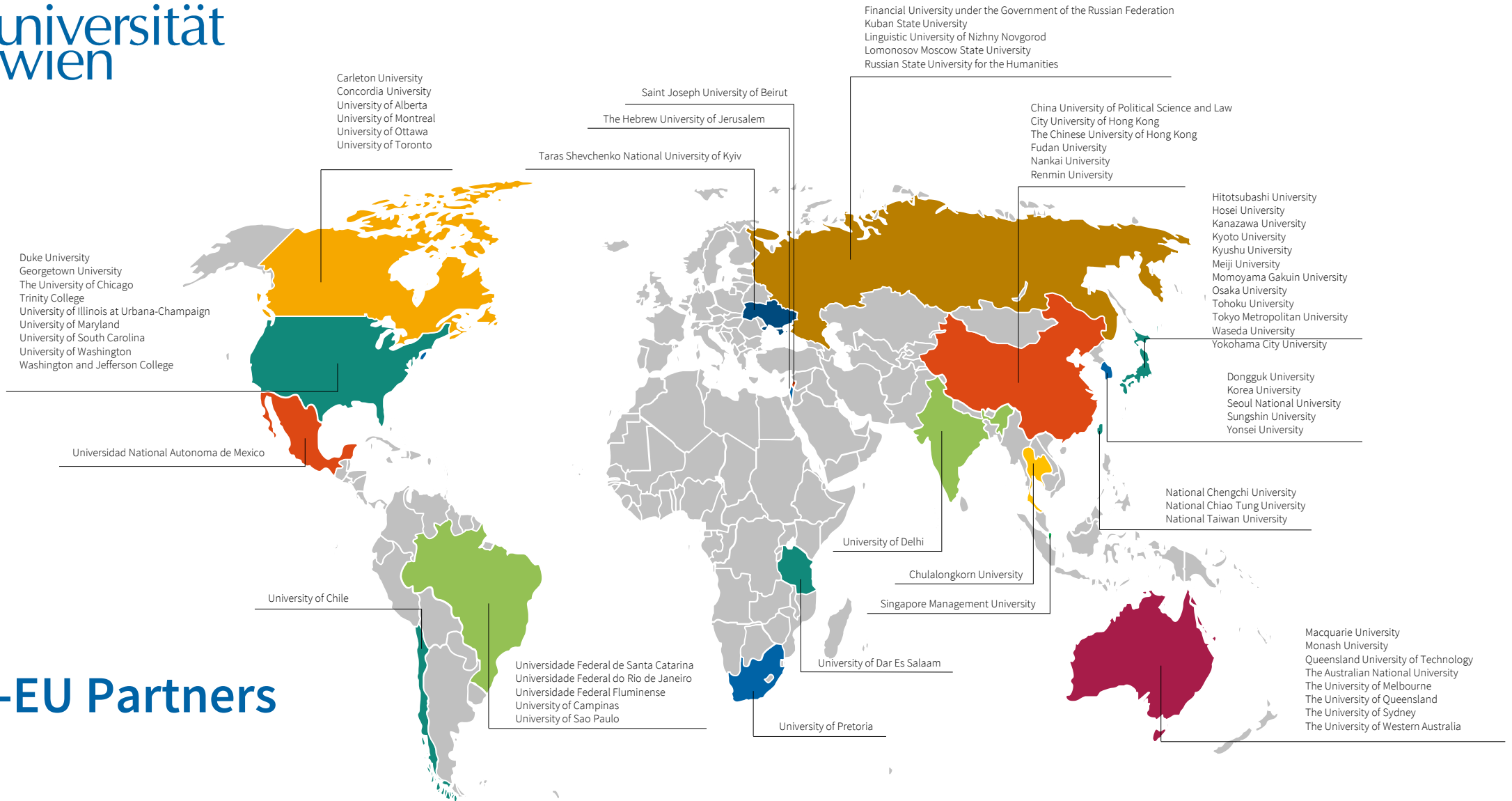
Non-EU Student Exchange Program

Exchange at a non-European partner university for BA, MA

- Exchange spots at **non-European** partners - currently approx. 60 partner universities in Africa, Asia, Australia, Americas, Israel, Lebanon, Russia, Ukraine
- Taking **courses** (min. 12 ECTS/semester), stays for **one or two semesters**
- Exemption of **tuition fees**, possibly grant: **€ 250 - 500 per month** (2023/24) & **travel allowance**
- **Application** at **International Office** (online, with language certificate!)
 - STEOP completed, min. 2 semester completed (BA, Diplom), exceeding max. 4 semesters the min. study period
 - Application deadlines:
 - 15 October** Africa & Asia
 - 15 November** USA, Canada, Australia
 - 1 February** Latin America, (Lebanon, Israel, Ukraine, Russia)
 - 15 May** Second application round for the summer semester

Short-term Grants abroad (KWA)

Worldwide stays for research for MA, PhD

- **Research work** as part of the **thesis**
- **Literature research, laboratory work, field research**, research in **archives, scientific collections** etc.
- **min. 2 weeks, up to 3 months**
- Grant: **€ 650 – 1.100 per month** (2023/24), **travel allowance**; possibly **exemption from tuition fees at the University of Vienna**
- **Application** at **International Office** (online, with language certificate!)
 - Topic for the thesis must already be approved!
 - Application deadlines: **15. February, 15. May** and **15. October**

Erasmus+ EU Educational Program

- **12 mobility months** per study cycle (up to 36 months)
→ **Multiple stays possible**
- Stays in **three programs** possible
- Program countries: **EU + partner countries**



Erasmus+ Traineeship

Study-related traineeships in Europe for BA, MA, PhD

- Traineeship must be **self-organized**
- **Working** in companies, NGOs etc., **research traineeship** at universities, **language assistance** in schools etc.
- Grant for **min. 2 full months, up to 5 months**
- Erasmus+ grant: **€ 570 – 670 per month**(2023/24), **Top-Ups**; possibly exemption from tuition fee
- **Recognition** possible, but not necessary; traineeship also possible for **recent graduates**
- **Application** at **International Office** (online, with language certificate!)
 - Any time
 - Deadline: 6 weeks prior to traineeship
 - For recent graduates: Application prior to last examination, traineeship after graduation

Erasmus+ International Mobility

Stay at a non-European Erasmus+ partner university for BA, MA, PhD

- Exchange spots for **specific study fields** (e.g. in Albania, Georgia, Indonesia...)
- Partner universities and study fields may change every year
- Taking **courses** or working on **thesis**
- Stays for **one semester** (max. 4 months)
- Erasmus+ grant: **€ 700 per month** (2023/24), **travel allowance**, exemption from **tuition fees**
- **Application** at **International Office** (online, with language certificate!)
 - STEOP completed; exceeding the min. study period for max. 4 semesters
 - Application deadline: winter semester **1. February**/summer semester **1. October**

Erasmus+ Student Exchange: key data

- Agreements with **24 partner universities** for BA/MA KSA and **6 partner universities** for CREOLE
- Stays for **one** (or with extension two) **semester(s)**
- **Erasmus+ grant** for min. 3 months: € 420-520/month (2023/24,) possible **Top-Ups**
- **Erasmus+ is a full-time study program, 30 ECTS recommended.**
 - **Min. requirement:** 3 ECTS per month recognized towards your degree at the University of Vienna.
- **Applications in several study programs possible**





Complete process in online tool **Mobility Online** (from application to final documents)

1. **Create a new application in Mobility Online** (for MA CREOLE additional submission to the Mobility Coordinator in person)
2. **Up to 3 preferences possible** ☑ higher chances
3. **Nomination** by Mobility Coordinator
4. **Information to all applicants** by e-mail by the International Office
5. Application at the host university

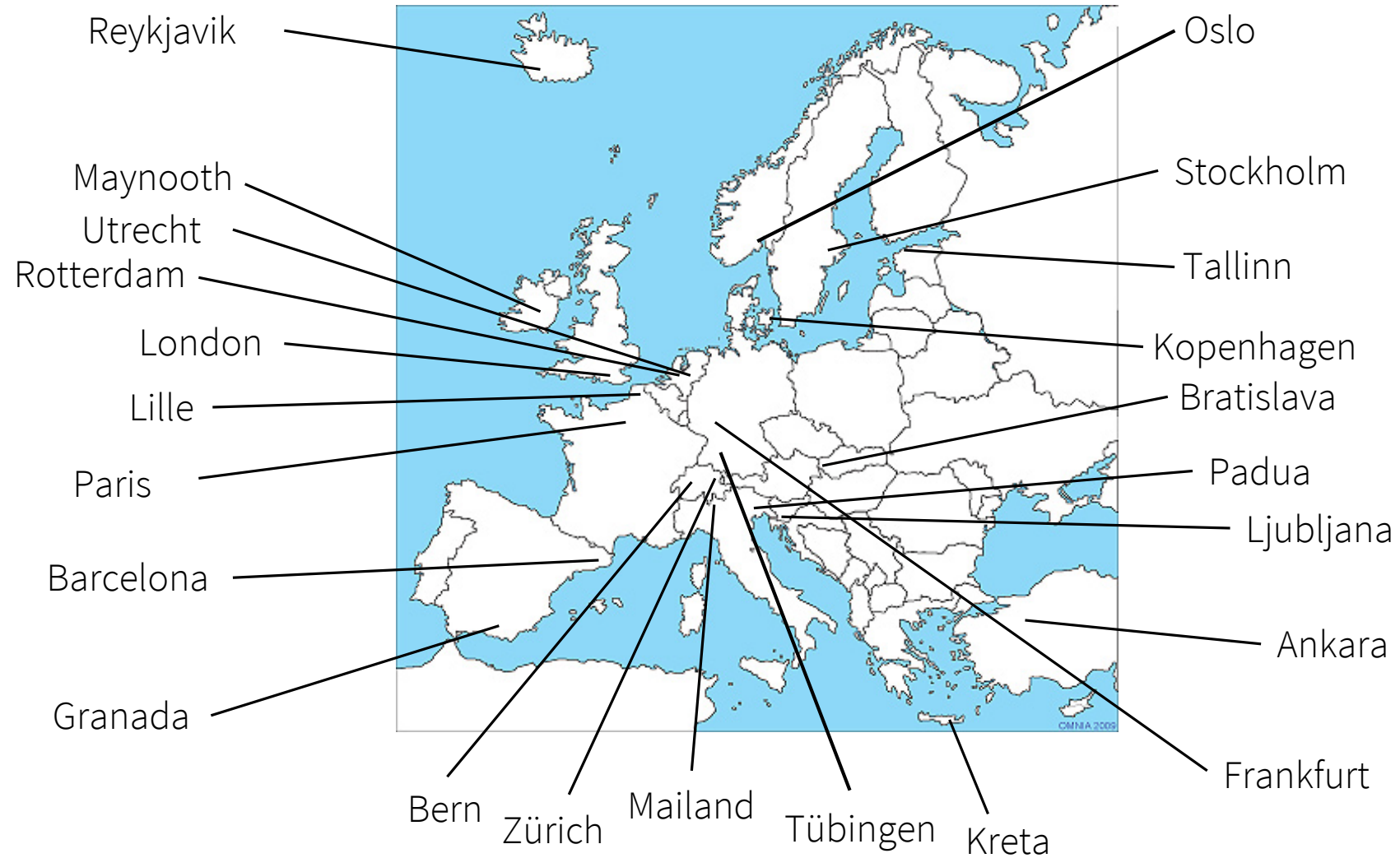

 - Was erwarten Sie sich von Ihrem Aufenthalt in wissenschaftlicher und persönlicher Hinsicht?
 - Fachliche Begründung der gewählten Plätze und Prioritätensetzung
- **Identitätsnachweis (Pass, Personalausweis)**





Auswahlkriterien – BA/MA KSA

- **Formale Voraussetzungen** sind erfüllt
- **Höhersemestrige** haben Vorrang
- **Notendurchschnitt**
- **Fachliche Motivation**

- Organized as **Erasmus+ Student Exchange**
- **Requirements:**
 - **Enrolled** in the MA CREOLE
 - Completed **registration of master's thesis and supervision**
- Designed for **two semesters abroad at one of the partner universities**
- Compulsory **Intensive Program (IP):**
 - One week at one of the partner universities in summer
 - Student conference/Presentation and feedback for master's project
 - **IP 2024:** Maynooth, Ireland, June 16th to 22nd (with financial support for the students)

Selection criteria

- **Formal qualifications** are fulfilled
- **Quality and feasibility** of the master's project
- **Fit of master's project and partner university**
- **Language skills**
- Before being nominated, you will be invited to an **informal interview on your master's project and plans** with the coordination team.

- 1. Check the courses offered by the host university**
 - Online course catalogue
- 2. Plan your study program**
 - Mind the compatibility of the ECTS and course content with your curriculum at the University of Vienna
- 3. Discuss your study program in Erasmus consultation**
 - Communicate changes by e-mail
- 4. Fill in your study program in Mobility Online**
- 5. Confirmation by SPL/host university in Mobility Online**

Bachelor KSA

- LVs für **BM6 Regionale Perspektiven** und **BM7 Zentrale Forschungsfelder** sind besonders geeignet
- LVs für **BM4 Methoden, BM5 Anthropologien: Trad., Texte, Deb. 2** und **BM9 Anthropologie Anwenden** sind möglich für eine Anrechnung
- **Alternative Erweiterungen** (15 ECTS) auch für fachfremde Kurse

Master KSA

- Besonders geeignet sind **MM3 Disziplinäre Spezialisierung, MM4 Methoden** und **MM5a Disz. Spez.: Vertiefung**
- Bei Genehmigung durch die SPL ist auch **MM5b Interdisziplinäre Ergänzung** möglich

Possibilities for recognition

Consultations can also be arranged before the nomination via erasmus.ksa@univie.ac.at.

Master CREOLE

- Courses for **Thematic Modules 1 & 2** are available at all partner universities, although not all partners offer all three thematic fields
- **Teacher Exchange** courses in the **CREOLE Erasmus Module International Track** are possible, but not always available at the partner universities
- ECTS for the **Intensive Program** DO NOT count towards the Erasmus+ stay
- The **Research Report** for **CREOLE Thesis Module 1** is possible, but has to be included in the host university's transcript of records
- **CREOLE Thesis Module 2** is possible
- Generally the **partner universities have similar curricula**, but module/course names might differ. Thus, make sure the amount of ECTS corresponds!

Learning Agreement for Studies

- Central document in the Erasmus+ program
- Listing of courses, you want to take at the host university
- **The Learning Agreement** is created directly in **Mobility Online** and digitally signed/confirmed (by student, SPL, host university)
- **Versioning:**
 - **Before the stay:** create first version
 - **During the stay/extension:** adapt
 - **For recognition:** separate application form „Antrag auf Anerkennung“
